

Membership



The Keowee Sailing Club is located on Lake Keowee, one of the most beautiful lakes in the Southeast. With a view of the Blue Ridge Mountains, and some of the clearest waters in America, Lake Keowee covers 18,500 acres of water and more than 300 miles of shoreline, much of it still undeveloped.

The Keowee Sailing Club was formed in 1972, and now occupies four acres of waterfront property, which commands one of the finest views on the lake. The facilities include a clubhouse with meeting space, an open air casual dining pavilion, kitchen, restrooms with showers, two beach areas, playground, picnic tables, and grills. We have slips for over 130 sailboats, and a large parking area for trailerable boats which are launched at our private launch ramp.

Our membership includes experienced sailors as well as newcomers to the sport, who find the exchange of ideas and fellowship with other sailors to be one of the greatest benefits of membership! These sailors often hail from other parts of the country, and they now make Lake Keowee and the Keowee Sailing Club their home port.

KSC Activities

Racing: As with any active sailing club, the racing program is an important part of the KSC schedule. Visiting boats trailer in for the big open regattas—the *Keowee Cup* in the spring, and the *Turkey Shoot Regatta* in the fall. In addition, the regular weekend club races are open to all levels of sailors. Special regattas, such as the *Bare*

What You Dare catamaran regatta attract specific fleets of racing boats for a weekend of racing and socializing.

Junior Sailing: To promote junior sailing and encourage young sailors, KSC hosts a summer Junior Sailing Camp for youths age ten and over. A program of sailing instruction taught by a certified instructor is mixed with fun activities during several days of camping at the club. The kids learn to rig and sail the club's small daysailers without assistance.
