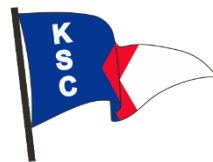


# 2018 Turkey Shoot Regatta

## NOTICE OF RACE

Revision F – 10/2/2018

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The Turkey Shoot Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 *Racing Rules of Sailing* and the one design rules for the boats for which a separate one design class has been established.
- 1.2. All changes will appear in full in the Sailing instructions and on the official Notice Board.
- 1.3. Changes to the Sailing Instructions may be made on the water by the race committee by raising the Come within Hail flag and repeated oral statements of the change as allowed by 90.2(c)

### 2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all sailboat types under 35 feet in overall length with a PHRF, Portsmouth, or SCHRS rating.
- 2.2. A Recreational Fleet may sail a long-distance course using existing fixed government marks and/or islands as rounding marks.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing registration contained for this regatta on the Keowee Sailing Club website ([www.keoweesailingclub.com](http://www.keoweesailingclub.com)) or in person onsite during the registration period.

### 3. BOATS/MEASUREMENT

- 3.1. All boats racing under PHRF handicap will be assigned a PHRF rating by the Race Committee using Keowee Sailing Club historical data or national average PHRF figures as a guide.
- 3.2. All boats registered under Portsmouth will be assigned a rating through the most current US Sailing Portsmouth Rating Guide. Wind ranges will not be utilized.
- 3.3. Multihulls who are not racing one design will be assigned a rating using SCHRS (Small Catamaran Handicap Rating System) – see <https://schrs.com> for more information.
- 3.4. Each competitor will be responsible for their boat’s compliance with its class rules.

### 4. FEES

Per boat regatta entry fee - adult	\$55.00 (includes 1 meal ticket and 1 shirt)
Per boat regatta entry fee - youth/college*	\$25.00 (includes 1 meal ticket and 1 shirt)
Additional meal & entertainment tickets	\$15.00 per person
Additional Regatta Shirts	\$15.00 ea.

## **5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

### Friday, October 26

- 1400 – Clubhouse grounds open
- 1730 – Onsite registration is open
- 2000 – Onsite registration is closed
- 1830 – Hors d'oeuvres

### Saturday, October 27

- 0730 – Breakfast is served
- 0800 – Onsite registration opens
- 1030 – Onsite registration closes
- 1100 – Competitor's meeting and bag lunches available for pickup
- 1200 – First signal
- 1830 – Dinner and Party

### Sunday, October 28

- 0800 – Breakfast provided by the KSC Commodore
- 1000 – First signal
- 1500 – Latest race start
- 1530 or ASAP – light lunch and Awards presentation at the KSC clubhouse

## **6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 6.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and on the Keowee Sailing Club website in the Turkey Shoot Regatta area ([www.keoweesailingclub.com](http://www.keoweesailingclub.com)).

## **7. SCORING**

- 7.1. Low point scoring, A2.1, is modified to read: "Each boat's series score shall, subject to rule 90.3(b), be the total of her races scores excluding her single worst score if four or more races are completed and excluding her two worst scores if eight or more races are completed. A minimum of one race constitutes a regatta.
- 7.2. PHRF scoring system will be time on time. Portsmouth scoring system will use the Portsmouth Yardstick. SCHRS scoring system will use the Small Catamaran Handicap Rating System.
- 7.3. Two or more races may be attempted each day for ALL fleets, except the Recreational Cruising fleet, time and weather permitting.

## **8. PRIZES**

- 8.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each fleet.

## **9. SAFETY**

- 9.1. All boats shall comply with their class rules and local governing authorities for safety equipment.

## 10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
