## Important Clubhouse Info

For the wellbeing of the clubhouse:

**Refrigerators** - There have been recent issues with ice buildup and water leaking under the fridge. The problem has been fixed but could happen again. Please keep the fridge clean; do not leave pieces of plastic or open food that can find their way into tubes. If the fridge is unplugged, make sure it has been fixed before plugging it in again. There is probably a reason that it is unplugged! Make sure the appropriate people are notified of any issues so that repairs can be made in a timely manner.

**Locks** - There continues to be an issue with unlocked doors including the door to the storeroom. Please make sure that all doors are locked when you leave any room if you are the last one there.

**Trash** - Trash containers in the kitchen need to be lined properly in order for them to work. If they are not then food and trash collects in the bottom of the trash container. Eventually, it results in odors and potentially other problems. When you replace the trash bag make sure you remove the plastic bin, dress the liner around it, and then -while holding any extra- put the bin back into the unit. None of the pink drawstring should be showing inside. It only takes a minute to do this correctly and will result in an orderly kitchen. Thanks!
