In January, the 2015 BOS will confirm approval of the budget.

This is also the time for Annual Election of Officers. Nominations have been received and a slate of candidates is being prepared at this time. There are nine candidates for the six positions as Steward, so your vote is very important. Watch your mailbox (snail, not email) for your ballot package and be sure to follow instructions carefully when casting your ballot. Ballots must be received at KSC no later than November 21 in order to be counted during the November 22 BOS Meeting. Results will be announced at the Annual Meeting immediately following.
