MESSAGE FROM THE VICE COMMODORE

SELF-HELP PROGRAM (WORK CREDIT)

Work hours on approved projects (work days, race committee, club events) or at the member's own convenience will qualify for self-help credits. It is the responsibility of the member to see that earned credit hours are recorded. Sheets for signing both in and out are available in the Clubhouse. **Make sure you write legibly.**

Members who work will be allowed a deduction per hour worked from their dues liability, up to an annual maximum credit of 40 hours (regardless of extra hours worked in excess of 40). Members will receive one-fourth of their earned credit (from Nov. 1-Oct. 31) at each of the four billings for the following fiscal year (Jan. 1-Dec. 31).

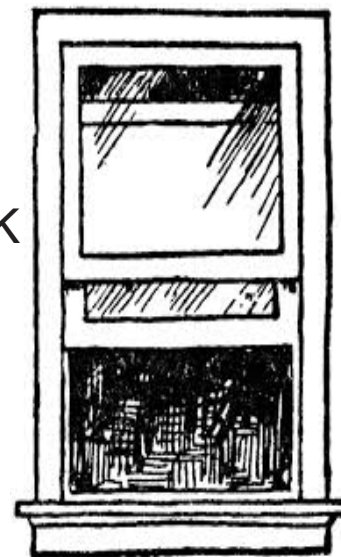
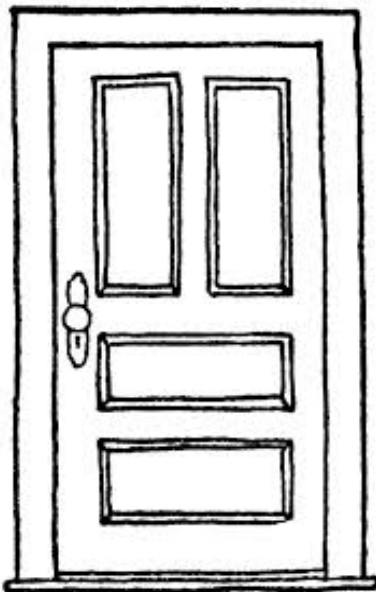
