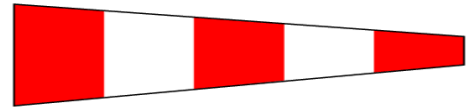

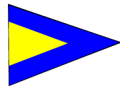

DOCKMASTER REPORT – AD CLAESSEN

When you need a slip in the water, a place to park a boat on its trailer in the upper lot, or a space for a boat on the beach, you need to contact the dock master for assignment. The cost is \$99 per quarter for a wet slip and \$36 per quarter for dry storage in the upper lot or on the beach. You will need to fill out a slip rental agreement, available on the web site. You also need proof of boat insurance. At this moment the dry storage in the upper lot is full and I will have to start a waiting list. For the docks there are 6 wet slips available. The dock capacity is 128 slips up to 27' boat length and 12 slips up to 30' boat length. The dry storage capacity is 60 boats on trailers, no empty trailers may be stored. There are also 3 work spaces to work on your boat, these need to be reserved with the dock master as well.
